9 (b) Duties.--The council shall do the following:

10 (1) Gather information from municipal officers, building  
11 code officials, construction code officials, licensed design  
12 professionals, builders and property owners concerning issues  
13 with the Uniform Construction Code raised by council members  
14 or changes proposed by members of the General Assembly.

15 (2) Evaluate the information compiled under paragraph  
16 (1) and make recommendations to the following:

17 (i) The Governor.

18 (ii) The Secretary of Labor and Industry.

19 (iii) The members of any legislative committee  
20 considering amendments to this act.

21 (iv) The President pro tempore of the Senate.

22 (v) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.

23 (vi) The Code Development Councils of the  
24 International Code Council.

25 (3) With the exception of the provisions of Chapter 11  
26 and Appendix E of the International Building Code of 2009, or  
27 its successor codes, or any other accessibility requirements  
28 which shall be specified in the regulations contained in or  
29 referenced by the Uniform Construction Code relating to  
30 persons with physical disabilities, review the [latest  
31 triennial code revisions issued by the International Code  
32 Council, beginning with the 2012 codes,] provisions revised  
33 in published International Code Council updates subsequent to  
34 the latest Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code adoption,  
35 as provided under subsection (b.1).
