38 *The claimant shall be ineligible for compensation unless forty-
39 nine and one-half per centum (49.5%) of this amount was paid in
40 a quarter or quarters of the base year other than the highest
41 quarter.

42 (2) (i) The Table Specified for the Determination of Rate
43 and Amount of Benefits shall be extended or contracted annually,
44 automatically by regulations promulgated by the secretary. The
45 table shall be extended or contracted in accordance with the
46 following:

47 (A) The table shall be extended or contracted to a point
48 where the maximum weekly benefit rate shall equal sixty-six and
49 two-thirds per centum (66 2/3%) of the average weekly wage for
50 the thirty-six-month period ending June 30 preceding each
51 calendar year. If the maximum weekly benefit rate is not a

1 multiple of one dollar (\$1), it shall be rounded to the next
2 lower multiple of one dollar (\$1).

3 (B) When it is necessary to extend the table, it shall be
4 done in accordance with the following procedure:

5 (I) The words "or more" shall be deleted from the last line
6 under Part A, and an amount twenty-four dollars (\$24) greater
7 than the first entry in that line shall be substituted therefor.
8 [The words "amount required under section 401(a)(2)" shall be
9 deleted from the last line under Part C.]

10 (II) Part A shall be extended as much as necessary by adding
11 twenty-five dollars (\$25) to each amount of the preceding line.
12 At the point where the entry in Part B equals sixty-six and two-
13 thirds per centum ($66 \frac{2}{3}\%$) of the average weekly wage, the
14 first entry in Part A shall consist of an amount twenty-five
15 dollars (\$25) greater than the smaller amount in the preceding
16 line, and the words "or more" shall be added.

17 (III) Part B shall be extended in increments of one dollar
18 (\$1) until that point is reached where the amount is equal to
19 sixty-six and two-thirds per centum ($66 \frac{2}{3}\%$) of the average
20 weekly wage.

21 (IV) Part C shall be extended to the point where, under Part
22 B, the amount is equal to sixty-six and two-thirds per centum
23 ($66 \frac{2}{3}\%$) of the average weekly wage.

24 (a) The amount on each line in Part C [other than the last
25 line] shall be derived from the first entry on the same line in
26 Part A, in accordance with the following formula:

27 (First entry in Part A plus twenty-four dollars (\$24)) x 100
28 divided by fifty and one-half (50.5)

29 If the amount determined by this formula is not an even
30 multiple of one dollar (\$1), it shall be rounded to the next
31 higher multiple of one dollar (\$1).

32 [(b) The last line in Part C shall contain the words "amount
33 required under section 401(a)(2)."]

34 (C) When it is necessary to contract the table, it shall be
35 done by deleting all lines following that in which the amount in
36 Part B is sixty-six and two-thirds per centum ($66 \frac{2}{3}\%$) of the
37 average weekly wage, substituting the words "or more" for the
38 higher amount under Part A on that line [and substituting the
39 words "amount required under section 401(a)(2)" for the amount
40 under Part C on that line].

41 (D) The Table Specified for the Determination of Rate and
42 Amount of Benefits as so extended or contracted shall be
43 effective only for those claimants whose benefit years begin on
44 or after the first day of January of such calendar year.

45 (ii) For the purpose of determining the maximum weekly
46 benefit rate, the Pennsylvania average weekly wage in covered
47 employment shall be computed on the basis of the average annual
48 total wages reported (irrespective of the limit on the amount of
49 wages subject to contributions) for the thirty-six-month period
50 ending June 30 (determined by dividing the total wages reported
51 for the thirty-six-month period by three) and this amount shall

1 be divided by the average monthly number of covered workers
2 (determined by dividing the total covered employment reported
3 for the same thirty-six-month period by thirty-six) to determine
4 the average annual wage. The average annual wage thus obtained
5 shall be divided by fifty-two and the average weekly wage thus
6 determined rounded to the nearest cent.

7 (iii) Notwithstanding subclause (i), if the maximum weekly
8 benefit rate determined under subclause (i) is greater than five
9 hundred seventy-three dollars (\$573), the maximum weekly benefit
10 rate shall be subject to the following limitations:

11 (A) For calendar years 2013 through 2019, the maximum weekly
12 benefit rate shall be five hundred seventy-three dollars (\$573).

13 (B) For each calendar year 2020 through 2023, the maximum
14 weekly benefit rate may increase from year to year by an amount
15 that is no more than eight per centum (8%) of the maximum weekly
16 benefit rate for the preceding year.

17 (C) If the maximum weekly benefit rate determined under this
18 subclause is not an even multiple of one dollar (\$1), it shall
19 be rounded to the next lower multiple of one dollar (\$1).

31 (c) Whoever makes a false statement knowing it to be false,
32 or knowingly fails to disclose a material fact to obtain or
33 increase compensation or other payment under this act or under
34 an employment security law of the Federal Government and as a
35 result receives compensation to which he is not entitled shall
36 be liable to pay to the Unemployment Compensation Fund a sum
37 equal to fifteen per centum (15%) of the amount of the
38 compensation. The sum shall be collectible in the manner
39 provided in section 308.1 or 309 of this act for the collection
40 of past due contributions and by any other means available under
41 Federal or State law. No administrative or legal proceeding for
42 the collection of the sum may be instituted after the expiration
43 of ten years following the end of the benefit year with respect
44 to which the sum was paid.
